TASTING NOTES Bream Creek has been producing Cabernet Sauvignon since its inception in the early 1970's, and without question the 2005 is the best ever. This has been vindicated by its recent show success – Trophy for “Best Other Red Variety or Blend” at the 2008 Tasmanian Wine Show.

The 2005 vintage is a showcase for classy Tasmanian Cabernet. The nose is alive with wild berry fruit, black currant and ripe plum. The palate is complex with firm tannins, excellent structure and delightful dark berry fruit and licorice characters.

COLOUR Deep purple red

BOUQUET Plum, Black Currant, Wild Berry Fruit, Subtle Oak

PALATE Complex, well structured, firm tannins, dark berry and licorice characters.
