Bream Creek

Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's naturally cool climate and has been rewarded with 19 trophies and over 394 show medals since 1990. The 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1973, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

## 2011 Bream Creek Riesling



### *Tasting Note*

On the mainland, vintage 2011 will go down as one of the worst vintages in living memory. However, once again Tasmania proved its resilience and cool climate advantage, as this wine illustrates.

Made from vines over 40 years old, this wine has a rich nose, showing lime and a touch of lemon. The palate is well balanced, with taut and lively acidity offset by the generous lime fruit for which Tasmanian Rieslings are known, a touch of creaminess and good length. This wine would be perfectly suited to Asian food or seafood, such as East Coast crayfish and aioli.
