Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's naturally cool climate and has been rewarded with 20 trophies and over 470 show medals since 1990. Our 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1974, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

### **Tasting Note**

Vintage 2012 will be remembered, on the whole, as an extraordinary vintage in Tasmania, equal perhaps to the famous vintage of 2005. Growing conditions were simply perfect and produced wines of outstanding intensity, depth and length.

A vibrant golden colour in the glass, an initial swirl reveals aromas of ripe peaches, roasted cashew nuts and toast. The palate is balanced and textural, flavours of stone fruit supported by fine acidity and the judicious use of well integrated French oak. An elegant and complex wine with a refreshing finish and excellent cellaring potential, it would be a fantastic accompaniment for rich foods, such as local herb roasted Marion Bay chicken.
