Bream Creek

Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's naturally cool climate and has been rewarded with 20 trophies and over 400 show medals since 1990. Our 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1974, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

Tasting Note

Vintage 2012 will be remembered, on the whole, as an extraordinary vintage in Tasmania. Growing conditions were simply perfect and produced wines of outstanding intensity, depth and length.

Made from vines over 40 years old, this wine has a rich nose, showing rich lime juice and lime curd aromas. The palate reveals taut and lively acidity perfectly balanced against the generous lime fruit for which Tasmanian Rieslings are known. With excellent length this wine would be perfectly suited to Asian food or seafood, such as East Coast crayfish and aioli.
