Bream Creek

Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's naturally cool climate and has been rewarded with 20 trophies and over 400 show medals since 1990. Our 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1974, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

Tasting Note

Vintage 2012 will be remembered, on the whole, as an extraordinary vintage in Tasmania. Growing conditions were simply perfect and produced wines of outstanding intensity, depth and length.

VGR denotes "Variable Grams Residual" natural grape sugar, which means we balance a higher level of residual grape sugar with the natural acidity of the wine. This wine shows a nose redolent with lime juice, floral notes and a touch of honey. The palate is exceptionally well balanced, smooth and full bodied and seamless, highlighting the Meyer Lemon fruit.

Despite its luscious palate, this Riesling has a refreshing finish and is ideal with seafood and Asian style cuisine.
