Bream Creek

Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's naturally cool climate and has been rewarded with 19 trophies and over 394 show medals since 1990. The 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1973, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere

### *Tasting Note*

Vintage 2013 was a dream vintage in many ways – great flowering, relatively dry weather with low disease pressure and a warmer than average summer, which provided the warmth and length in the season to fully mature the grapes.

Classic and full flavoured Sauvignon Blanc style with aromas of gooseberry and hints of honeydew melon. An elegant balanced wine with a classic cool climate, full flavoured palate showing gooseberry, citrus fruits and a touch of herb.

Nicely structured with a pleasant texture and refreshing finish, this wine is ideal with aperitifs, seafood or informal entertaining.
