



Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's pristine cool climate and has been rewarded with over 20 trophies and more than 470 show medals since 1990. Our 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1974, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

Tasting Note

Vintage 2016 was simply spectacular in Tasmania. Perfect growing conditions provided the platform to grow fruit that was of excellent quality, with fantastic balance between flavour and physiological ripeness.

This dessert wine – made from the extremely rare German Schönburger grape – shows delicate aromas of apricot marmalade, poached yellow peaches and crystallised ginger. The palate is smooth and elegant, rich yellow stone fruit flavours matched with a clean and refreshing finish.

Well balanced, this versatile dessert wine can match soft cheeses or decadent desserts with equal aplomb!
