



Bream Creek Vineyard produces premium wines from Tasmania's pristine cool climate and has been rewarded with over 20 trophies and more than 470 show medals since 1990. Our 7.5ha vineyard at Marion Bay in the south-east of Tasmania was originally planted in 1974, making it one of the oldest commercial vineyards on the island. Fred Peacock purchased the vineyard in 1990 and expanded the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay plantings, as well as introducing Sauvignon Blanc. Fred also planted what was arguably the first commercial planting of the rare German grape Schönburger in the southern hemisphere.

### ***Tasting Note***

Vintage 2016 was simply spectacular in Tasmania. Ideal growing conditions provided the perfect platform to grow fruit that was of excellent quality, with perfect balance between flavour and physiological ripeness.

This extremely limited wine was made from the oldest commercial Riesling block in Tasmania. These vines - now 43 years old – are located in C Block in our picturesque East Coast vineyard. Vibrant citrus and grape fruit flavours are enmeshed in a web of lively Tasmanian acidity, finishing with excellent length and a crisp, dry finish. It is perfectly suited to fresh Bruny Island oysters or grilled Pirates Bay octopus.
